## A Message from our Community Spiritual Director

As a chaplain I feel extremely blessed to journey with patients, family members and hospital staff in their most challenging times and sometimes in their most triumphant moments. I see in these people God's amazing grace. I end each day thanking God for the many blessings I continue to receive and more often than not I also end the day realizing that although I am in the business of serving people it is I who so often feels served. My life is continually enriched by all these people I meet each day; I sit with each day and talk with each day. The other night proved to be no different. In my position at the hospital where I work I am privileged to attend and sometimes facilitate various support groups. The most recent one I attended was a Spinal Injury Support Group. For an hour I listened to the guest speaker talk about his paralysis caused by



an accident he experienced at the age of 19. I listened as he spoke about thinking that his life was over and that he would never experience all the things that "normal" people experience in their lives. Then someone said to him that he should consider his life to be a book. He had a choice: he could write a boring book, without substance or he could spend his life writing the most fascinating, exciting and meaningful book possible. By God's grace, the speaker told us, he began to write his book, to live his life. This man has become successful in the business world in his wheelchair, lectures around the world in his wheelchair, has climbed mountains in his wheelchair, completed marathons in his wheelchair, married the woman he loved in his wheelchair and helps raise his children in his wheelchair. He lives a very large, very full life in his wheelchair and yet he is not defined by his disability, he is defined by the content of his heart. He is defined by his life of grace and his willingness to live that life. By all standards he does not live a "normal" life; he lives an extraordinary life.

God offers to all of us a life of grace and we are given a choice to accept it or not. We are given a choice to offer that same grace to other people or not. I pray that each one of you will spend each day writing an amazing life story. I pray that each one of you finds your way to living a life of grace and offering that grace to all around you.


