Isaiah 9:6 Romans 8:15-16, Exodus 3:5

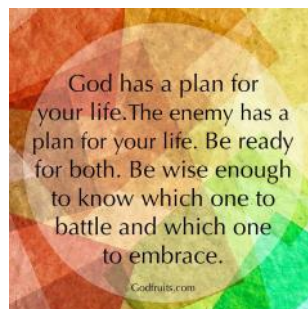
I just had to share that, and I pray that each of you are "on the lookout" for all He has prepared for you.

Keeping Focus in a Busy World

As I write this newsletter, I'm feeling like "where did the time go?" It seems the older I get, the shorter the days become. Like many of you, my appointment calendar chases me from sun up until sun down and my "things to do list" seems to grow while I'm sleeping at night. Do this..., next that..., you want it when? We live event driven lives.

And even in the IDGB community, we can be consumed by dates and commitments. We prepare for upcoming weekends by marching through our meeting schedule and "Snap!" they are over in a flash. The memories and memorabilia of two fantastic weekends are hardly put away before we begin recruiting for the upcoming weekends. (And, yes, framing the team pictures from previous banquet weekends *is* on my things to do list.)

Now don't get me wrong; I would not willingly give up any of these activities. It's been said that the secret to fulfillment is to remain purposeful, flexible, and work at something you love. A wise man once told me that "From the time we are born until we reach 40 years of age, we take and learn. From 40 years old on, we teach and give back." I am in the teaching and giving back stage of life and I love it. I love my vocation as a pastor and my job. I love my congregation and I love the Indiana Dunes Great Banquet community, and most of all, I love the people that make up each. As do most of you. Augustine of Hippo wrote, "Work like everything depends on you. Pray like everything depends on God." By intentionally being open about my faith, I was able to share my testimony with one of my business associates during a 4-hour drive from Denver, CO to Sinclair, Wyoming. We forged a deeper, more meaningful friendship with a commitment to pray for one another and intentionally call each other on a regular basis.

While sharing my faith traveling through Texas, I discovered that I have Cursillistas residing in our Houston office. You can imagine the experiences we shared. If we remain intentional and open to the leading of the Holy Spirit, we can find God's work and purpose even in the midst of our overwhelming schedules. God has a purpose for all that we do if we offer it to Him. He has a plan and a season for that plan. We cannot be overworked or overwhelmed if we remember that He holds all in the palm of His hands.

I believe the secret to balancing a busy life can be found in Ecclesiastes chapter 3 where we find that there is a time for everything. Verses 1- 8 state: "For everything there is a season, and a time for every matter under heaven: a time to be born, and a time to die; a time to plant, and a time to pluck up what is planted; a time to kill, and a time to heal; a time to break down, and a time to build up; a time to weep, and a time to laugh; a time to mourn, and a time to dance; a time to cast away stones, and a time to gather stones together; a time to embrace, and a time to refrain from embracing; a time to seek, and a time to lose; a time to keep, and a time to cast away; a time to tear, and a time to sew; a time to keep silence, and a time to speak; a time to love, and a time to hate; a time for war, and a time for peace."

Think about that... It's not the number of things we do so much as it is to do each in its season, knowing that there is a time and place for all of life's activities.

It is in the midst of all our busyness that we can rely on the guidance of a loving, caring, Heavenly Father who will help us sort our priorities if we will bring them to Him in prayer. He will do His part as we strive to do our part. Augustine was right: "Work like everything depends on you. Pray like everything depends on God." We simply have to keep the main thing the main thing and not lose focus of our primary calling: to be committed followers of Jesus Christ and to make Him known to everyone we encounter.

My prayer is that each of us can pause, take a deep breath, commit all to God, and then press on... intentionally and purposefully, doing the work He has called us to do and witnessing to the person in front of you or beside you.

And please give prayerful consideration to serving on the upcoming weekends as I know Nancy & Ron are prayerfully looking for willing servants who will be the hands and feet of Jesus.

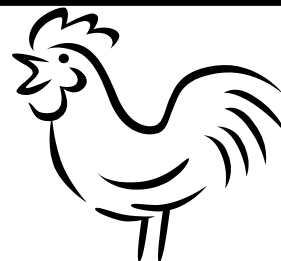

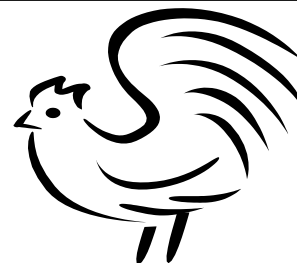
